How do I know a spray foam contractor is properly trained or certified?

All WALLTITE applicators are trained by BASF's technical experts. After training, the contractors are tested by the certification organization Caliber. The Caliber Quality Assurance Program (CAP) provides third-party certification of the applicators and unbiased inspection services to ensure the product is installed correctly.

DO YOUR HOMEWORK

While cost is an easy way to compare companies, you should also consider other factors such as experience and proven results before signing a contract. Make sure you've got a good understanding and know what to expect.

Look at Past Projects

Visiting the spray installer's website is a great place to learn more about them. Many companies will include their areas of specialization and details about their past projects.
